




## Getting to Know this Cloud-Based Video Editing Software

**Account Tab:** Where you can edit your profile settings and connect to social media.


# Getting Started

Click Start Upload**


Be sure to Import “Ev’rybody Smiles” Vocal Track and images in Picture folder

Video Editor Window Launches**



**Media Library (Upper Left):** Access to all private and shared clips - audio, video, graphics, effects and transitions.



**Viewer (Upper Right):** Playback clips or timeline content.


**Timeline:** Drag video clips, images, graphics, effects, and transitions from the Media Library. Trim clips here by dragging at the beginning or end of the clip.



**Transport Controls:** Tools above Timeline for playback.

# **Steps to Success**

## **Part 2**

**Click Play to hear the Audio of your song. Write down the timing of the end of each phrase.  
i.e., Intro ends at 6:24**

**Tip**  
**Spacebar = play/stop**  
**Enter/Return = back to beginning**

**Play piece until end of Introduction and  
Pause with spacebar (app. 6:22 = 6  
seconds and 22 frames)  
Log timing on next page**

**Tap spacebar to continue through the  
end of Phrase 1 and log timing**

**Repeat process for Phrases 2-4

# **Steps to Success**

## **Part 3**

**Add Title Screen**

**Click Videos Tab  
Drag Black Clip to MAIN lane on  
timeline**

**Click to select Black Clip.  
Click hold and drag the right arrow to  
make the video clip longer.  
It should end at about 6:24**

**Click TEXT Tab  
Choose Main Title or other graphic  
Click and Drag to beginning of  
Video 2 lane  
Trim so it is the same length or slightly  
shorter than the Black Video Clip**

**In Timeline, click on Main Title video  
Click Edit  
In gray box, replace text with Song title  
Highlight text and change fonts & color  
Click DONE**

# **Steps to Success**

## **Part 4**

**Play clip to observe title graphic.  
Is it the length of the Introduction?  
If not, click clip and  
click and drag end point to  
make longer or shorter**

**Click Media Tab  
Drag a Picture to the Main Track to be  
adjacent to the Black Movie**

**You can adjust the length of the picture  
by clicking on it and then click/drag the  
right arrow. You want it to end at the  
end of Phrase 1**

**Click the picture on the timeline and  
click EDIT to add an effect. Select and  
click DONE**

**Click Transitions Tab and Drag Cross  
fade or other transition to the point  
between the black video and picture 1  
on the timeline**
